

Custom Forms

- a) Crash Zone, Forms menu in Left Toolbox.
- b) Actual symbol names for custom forms.
 - a. Menu name: Custom Form 1 = Symbol name: **custom2**
 - b. Menu name: Custom Form 2 = Symbol name: **custom3**
 - c. Menu name: Diagram and Evidence Sheet = Symbol name: **custom1**
- c) Draw a new form or modify an existing form to make your own custom form.
- d) Select the entire form and click on the Properties button on the Speedbar at the top of the screen. Change its current layer to layer number 1023. This will ensure the form is erased and replaced with the most current form selected.
- e) Type YV (symbol remove) and click on “Select Unused Symbols”, then click “Remove”, then “Yes”. This will remove the previous form symbol from current memory so a new form can be saved under the same name.
- f) Select the new form.
- g) Type YC (symbol create).
- h) In the Speedbar menu at the top of the screen enter a symbol name using one of the form names you wish to replace (custom2, custom3, or custom1). It must be spelled exactly the same to replace the previous form.
- i) Select OK.
- j) The command line will prompt you to “Enter the first handle point”. Click on a point in the lower left hand corner of the drawing area of your form.
- k) “Enter the second handle point”. Click on a point in the upper right hand corner of the drawing area of your form.
- l) The new symbol will be saved to the “My Symbols” directory. You need to copy it from that directory to your \Crash Zone\Custom directory and overwrite the existing form symbol.
- m) Click on the button of the form you just modified. It should fit around anything currently on the drawing screen.
